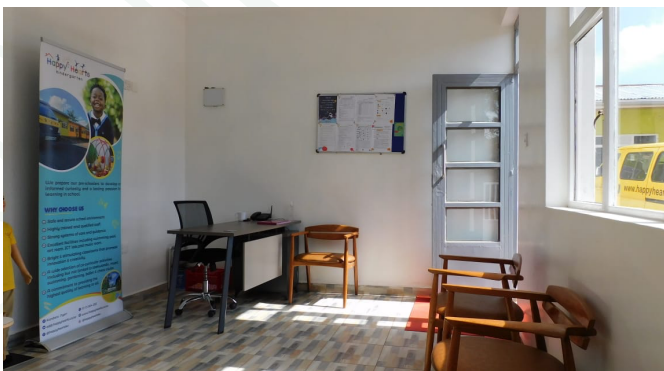

During this next term, we shall be having a school trip to Aberdare Country Club. School trip consent forms entailing further details about the trip will be sent out to the parents, kindly sign and return the forms one week before the due date. We shall hold our school spirit day dubbed school happy day for term 2 in August. On this day we shall have various exciting activities themed and planned for our learners. In addition we shall celebrate birthdays for August babies on this day. Last but not least we shall have the International Literacy Day celebrations that will be held as we approach the end of our second term. SCHOOL PROGRAMS AND FACILITIES:

We are happy to announce that:

Last term, We started a creche/daycare program that has received a good reception in the community. We enrolled ten (10) daycare students on short and long-term arrangements. Our charges are two hundred shillings per day for full board (a day's activities and meals) and one hundred shillings per day for half board (a day's activities and packed lunch from home). These charges do not include transportation. The kids are engaged in potty training, pre-academic, social interaction, and basic motor activities. Kindly, refer a daycare parent!



Next term, the school is introducing after-school activities at no extra charge. These activities include; Book Club on Mondays and Tuesdays to help develop pre-reading skills and improve comprehension. Periodically, Parents will be invited to join in the read-aloud sessions with the learners. Secondly we shall have Green Thumb on Wednesdays, a gardening club, and lastly Cookery club on Fridays to help develop pre-cooking skills. These will result in a change in the evening pick-up time to 3:30 pm.

CONSTRUCTION UPDATES:



We are delighted to note that we have completed the construction of our swimming pool and music room. We are committed to ensuring that our learners next term, start taking the swimming lessons, subject to weather conditions. Further, we are equipping our music room with music instruments to enhance our learners music studies.

We will also be fitting out our ICT lab and Art rooms ready for use during the next term. We intend to offer our young learners blended learning which uses technology at no extra charge. This will enable us to revamp our teaching methods and ensure continuous learning of our learners by using technology based learning platforms.

Over the holiday break, we are consulting with the school's nutritionist on how best to improve our meals. We shall therefore be reviewing our school menu to improve the meals offered to our learners.

Lastly, We have installed CCTV cameras in the school. CCTV surveillance systems are excellent deterrents against incidents occurring during school hours, whether it is bullying, unauthorised access, or vandalism. Security cameras can help to keep student safety at the forefront and can be used to identify bottleneck areas on the school premises.

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OUR PROMISE:

We are here to support you and your child's holistic growth journey. We highly appreciate your continuous support and constructive feedback. We do not take it for granted that we have a strong community of dedicated parents. As always, our channels to provide glows and grows feedback are always open. If you have any concerns, please continue to reach out to your child's class teacher. Our Principal, also remains available to provide support.

The entire team and I care deeply about the development and trajectory of our learners at school and beyond. We are committed to working tirelessly with you to build an exceptional community and environment for our students to grow into global citizens with the potential to provide a significant contribution to our community and the world at large.

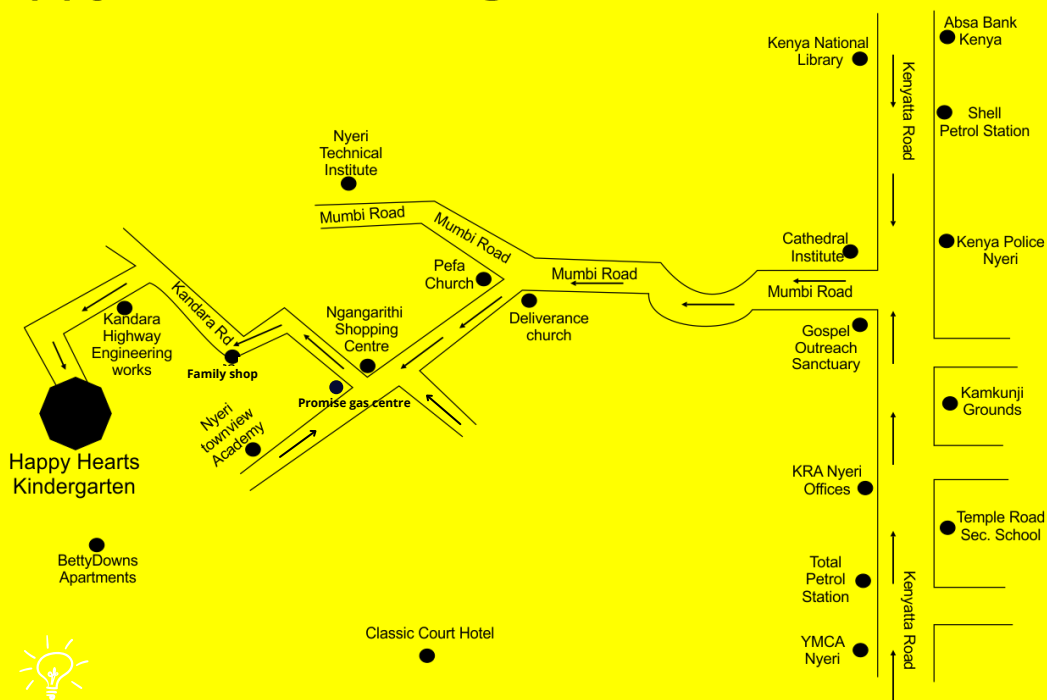
